Money for food for scholarship students - School of Hope

After floods, locust plagues, drought and now COVID-19 a famine is looming in East Africa, including Kenya, South Sudan, Ethiopia and Somalia.

Lonah Maiko, our GSP Program Officer, says that although the School of Hope community hasn't reported many cases, every family is struggling to afford food due to the shortages and increased prices.

GSP scholarship student's families recently received money for food – a huge thank you to our sponsor families who are helping these families through this very difficult time.

Schools in Kenya have been closed since March, with several proposed dates for re-opening having come and gone. Now schools are to re-open in January 2021 with all students repeating the entire year.

The School of Hope is negotiating to sell its land (to another GSP school) and if successful the two schools will merge.

This is a great sadness for us, as Moses and the School of Hope have been with GSP since 2011.
